My Style

My style is best described as a cross between candid and posed photography. I'll help get you into place first and then encourage interaction and real expressions while we're snapping away. I might ask you to snuggle, whisper something funny to each other, or play Simon Says. I love to get the special family shots but also those just-asspecial in between moments of snuggles, laughter and play.

I believe that photography should be fun and feel natural. My goal is for you to have amazing images at the end, but I want you to love the experience of being photographed as well. The best compliment of all time is when a dad tells me that he actually had fun, or when a 3-year-old doesn't want me to go home at the end. That's when I've done my job correctly!



EXPECT

1. Booking and Planning

Before your session, we will talk or email about what you're looking for in your photos and your vision for the session. If you don't know where to start, that's ok too! Just tell me a little about yourself and I'll suggest a game plan and location ideas. We'll reserve your session date, I'll send you an invoice for your deposit, and then it's official!

2. Your Session

This is the fun part! We'll meet for your photo session and spend time together creating amazing images. Most sessions tend to last about an hour, but we can take as long as we need.

3. Image Selection

After we meet, I'll spend time culling through and editing the best proofs from your session. Within about two weeks, I will send you an email with the link to your online gallery. Once you've placed your order, I'll do any final touch ups before sending your order.







- * Plan your outfits ahead of time. Wear comfortable clothes and dress for the weather.
- * Bring your child's favorite snack or toy for when we take breaks.
- * Tell your kids it's going to be fun get them excited about the shoot. (and bring bribes!)
- * Communicate your goal for the session.
- * Relax, have fun and trust your photographer!

What to bear

- Take some time at least a couple weeks before your session to plan your outfits. Try them on well in advance and make sure everyone's clothes are comfortable.
- Plan for the weather. Nothing is worse than being miserably uncomfortable in a perfect outfit. If you're planning an outdoor session in November, think about coats, gloves, and hats. In the summer, dress in layers that you can easily take off if you get too hot.
- Try to find outfits with a coordinating color palette instead of completely matching. You can create a coordinated look by taking one or two colors and pulling them through to each family member.
- Don't be scared of patterns and prints! They can work great in moderation. Try one statement piece (for instance, a colorful floral dress for mom) and one subtle pattern (maybe tiny polka dots for baby girl), and then keep the rest of the family more simple.
- Add layers and accessories. Layers add dimension to your outfit and make it more interesting. Don't be afraid to add scarves, blazers, jackets, belts, jewelry, headbands and hats.
- Don't Forget Shoes. These are often the forgotten last element, but they can really make or break your outfits! If you can't find shoes you love, consider going barefoot (just bring walking shoes to get from point A to point B).
- * Avoid clothing with big logos or text on them; they take attention away from faces.

FAQ's

What if it rains?

I watch the weather very closely and if it looks like we will get rained out, or if the heat/humidity is excessive, we will reschedule. If it's not raining, keep in mind that cloudy days often make for excellent lighting for photos.

Can you retouch blemishes?

Yes, I retouch all purchased photos and digital files at no additional charge.

When will my photos be ready?

Your proofs will be ready for viewing approximately 2 weeks after your session. Once you place your order, prints and products take about 1-2 weeks.

What about props?

I love using props in sessions and have a collection to choose from ranging from baskets and highchairs to wagons, chairs, blankets, etc.






